

Puerto Madryn is your gateway to adventure! Come and Explore it!


Being a tourist destination throughout the year, it offers connectivity by land air, either through its own airport, or the airport of the city of Trelew (only 40 miles away).



Magellanic Penguins

As one of the largest continental rookeries of **Magellanic**penguins, sheltering half a million individuals!


From the trail, observe, photograph and enjoy the amazing landscape: penguins in their burrows and in the sea; their behaviour during their breeding season in a natural setting of unpaired beauty.



You can walk among them without causing an impact; both at **Punta Tombo** penguin colony as in different sheep farms around this area.







The natural habitat of Southern Right whales, where they can be observed most of the year. As soon as you arrive in town, watch them from the inn, hotel or waterfront; enjoying a tasty breakfast or lunch overlooking the Gulf. You can also visit **El Doradillo** beach, a whale sanctuary, where you can witness their aquatic dances and their energy.

These beaches are an open-air stage from where to observe the whale mothers and their calves at short distance behind the surf (above all around the high tide).



Finally, a must-do excursion is whale-watching boat tour. These boat tours depart from the village of **Puerto Pirámides**. It is a 90 minute-boat ride.

A few minutes after departure, you might be already approaching whales, and see their different behaviours.

To ensure you enjoyment, the whale companies know about the weather conditions several hours in advance.

And to guarantee the welfare of the whales, the boats will not chase them for close observation, rather, the sighting will depend on the whales attitude, since one of the main features of this species is curiosity, therefore, they tend to approach the boats.








Sea Lions are found all year along the coast around Puerto Madryn and Peninsula Valdés, in permanent colonies and/or temporary ones. Watch them from the view points on the units of the Protected Natural Areas; and they will approach you during diving and snorkeling tours or during Kayak tours.


To observe **Elephant Seals**, you also need to get to the public viewpoints of the Protected Natural Areas throughout the year; only the number of individuals varies according to breeding or shedding season. This is the only continental region where they can be observed, since they typically inhabit islands.

On Peninsula Valdés, they can be seen in different locations.





Elephant Seals





Orcas can be observed along the coast of Peninsula Valdés mainly during the months of March, April, October and November, in accordance with the breeding season of sea lions and elephant seals.

The sightings take place from the public viewpoints at **Punta Norte and Caleta Valdés.** This is the only orca in the world known to hunt using the breathtaking technique called intentional stranding.



Dusky Dolphin



Dusky Dolphins are observed mainly in the summer months and from a boat. They travel in schools of two to a hundred individuals.

This tour has a duration of 03:00 hs. and includes the observation of sea lions and seabirds along the coast.



If you want to observe Commerson's dolphins, you will find them all year around Playa Unión, Rawson, at the mouth of the Chubut River in Rawson. These acrobatic dolphins swim at great speed interacting with the boats.

Our hosts will make you feel like you are in a documentary!

The wild and semi-arid conditions of the region made our land animals develop outstanding camouflage mechanisms.






The **4x4 excursion** is unique and exciting. 4 hours of pure adventure and discovery.

If you prefer dry land, trekking is ideal: walk on trails that lead to incredible places and discover landscapes that will leave you without breath.







This experience combines adventure, sports and nature.



The towns Gaiman, Dolavon and 28 de Julio are jewels on the Chubut River bank, where the Welsh, Tehuelche and Mapuche cultures created history still alive today. We invite you to visit this landscape of chapels and poplars, and the famous Welsh tea rooms.

Gaiman is an old Welsh settlement that has preserved its charm and heritage to the present day. You can enjoy the traditional Welsh tea service, visit the original protestant chapels scattered along the valley, and eventually enjoy choir music. Cherries and red berries are grown around Gaiman.

Located a few miles away, find the **Paleontological Park Bryn Gwyn**, a natural fossil area unique in its kind in Latin America, created by the Museum Egidio Feruglio (MEF).



Dolavon is the home for local popular events par excellence. It has earned its fame in recent years thanks to the organization of events

such as the "Chorilavon", the "KeiponFest", and/or the "Sanguchito World Cup", an event you cannot miss if you would like to try different, crazy sandwiches! The traditional Dolavon Carnival is also held here every year, and is part of Dolavon's magic.


A few kilometers away, you arrive at the picturesque town **28 de Julio**. Full of charm and authenticity, it will make you feel at home. Being here, you can appreciate the vastness of the valley flanked by hills on one side, and rows of Poplars trees on the other.

Finally, if you are looking for a break in nature, the **Dam Florentino Ameghino** is a perfect choice. Known as Patagonia's oasis, it dazzles with impressive red rock walls, lush vegetation and the grandeur of human construction work.









MUSEUMS AND VISITOR CENTRES

Once in Puerto Madryn, delve into the marine universe visiting the **Museum for Oceanographic and Natural Sciences**, and the **Ecocentro**: a centre dedicated to strengthening national sovereignty over our seas from a sustainable perspective. The Econcentro promotes our connection with nature through the fusion of interpretation, research, education and coastal-marine art

The **Ecocentro** gives an insight into one of the greatest natural wonders of



Argentina and our planet: Peninsula Valdés, a Natural World Heritage Site.

Like other visitor centres at the different Natural Protected Areas, the Ecocentre will introduce the visitor to the home of Southern Right whales, penguins, killer whales, dolphins, elephants and sea lions, guanacos, maras, choiques, armadillos, foxes and a great diversity of birds.

The Egidio Feruglio Palaeontology Museum (MEF) is







an invitation to discover the fascinating stories of this region's dinosaurs. Among them, the world's largest dinosaur to date: Patagotitan Mayorum, 38 meters long and almost 8 meters high.

The **MEF** exhibition hosts over 15 dinosaur species, about 200 plant species, and a valuable collection of fossilized pollen and seeds from South America.

A compelling experience for palaeontology lovers!

The **Astronomy Centre in Trelew** will welcome you with a mind-blowing cosmic tour. The Sky and the Stars. The








vast Patagonian Sky and its magnificence. A tour around the solar system and our planet earth from a privileged place!


they glow... and more.






